


Federal Inspection Services (FIS) Facility

- Largest facility of its kind in the United States
- 784,000 square feet of floor space over three levels (60,000 square feet of non-secure public space)
- Four pedestrian bridges connecting Terminal D & E to the FIS
- 84 FIS booths to process 4,500 arriving passengers per hour when fully staffed
- 12 baggage claim carousels
- 192 flight information display screens
- Used in construction:
 - 30,000 cubic yards of concrete
 - 15 million pounds of steel
 - 380,000 square feet of terrazzo flooring
 - 260 miles of electrical wire
 - One million linear feet of data cable
- One of the first facilities in the U.S. to launch the Global Entry Program
